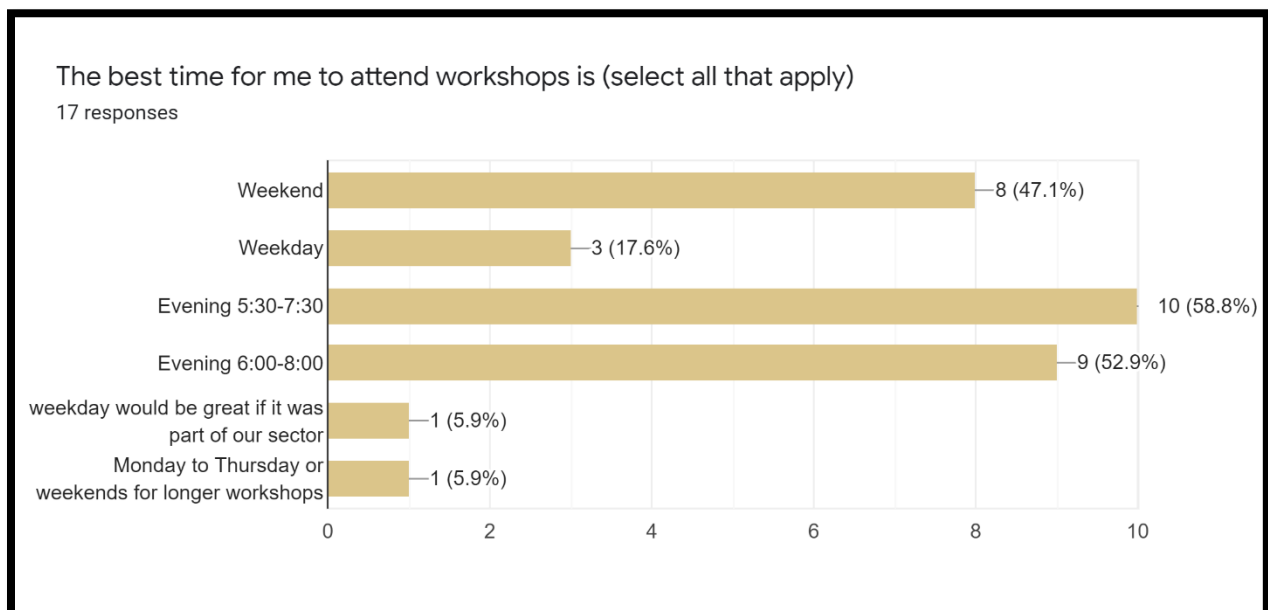
Where we are headed IF we end up in the Education Ministry

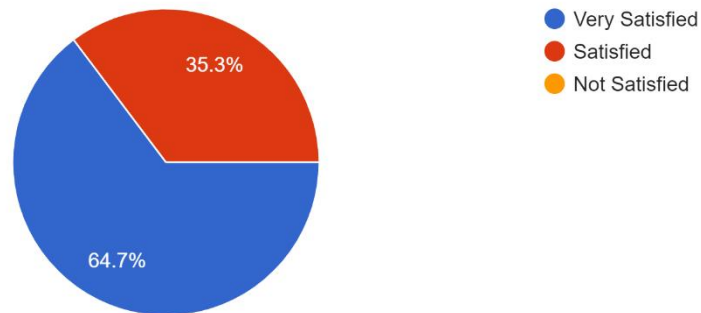

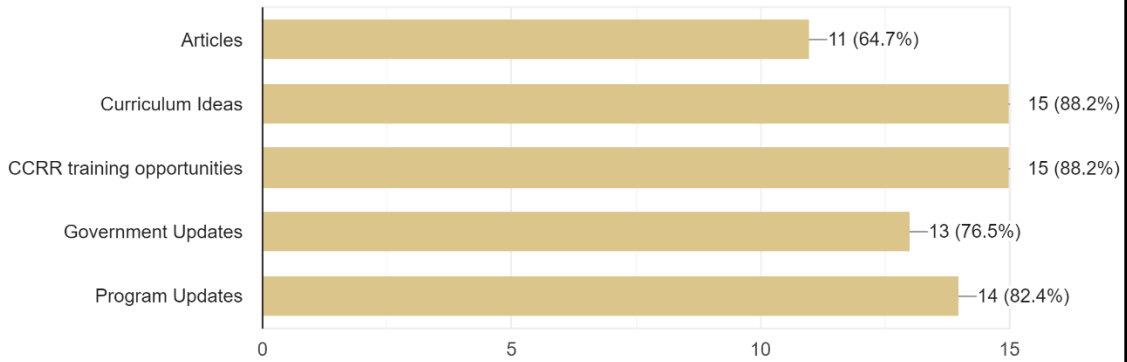
If noted that, were you were satisfied or not satisfied with the newsletter, what would need to change to make you very satisfied?

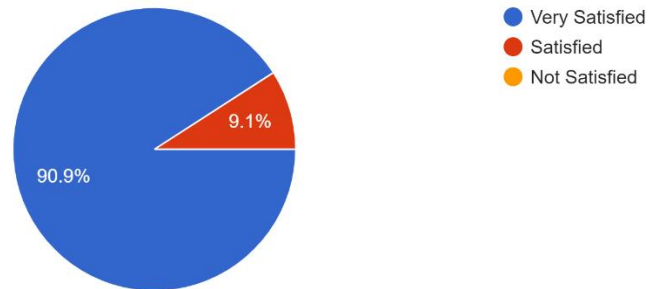
CCRR Newsletters: What information do you most look forward to reading in the newsletter?

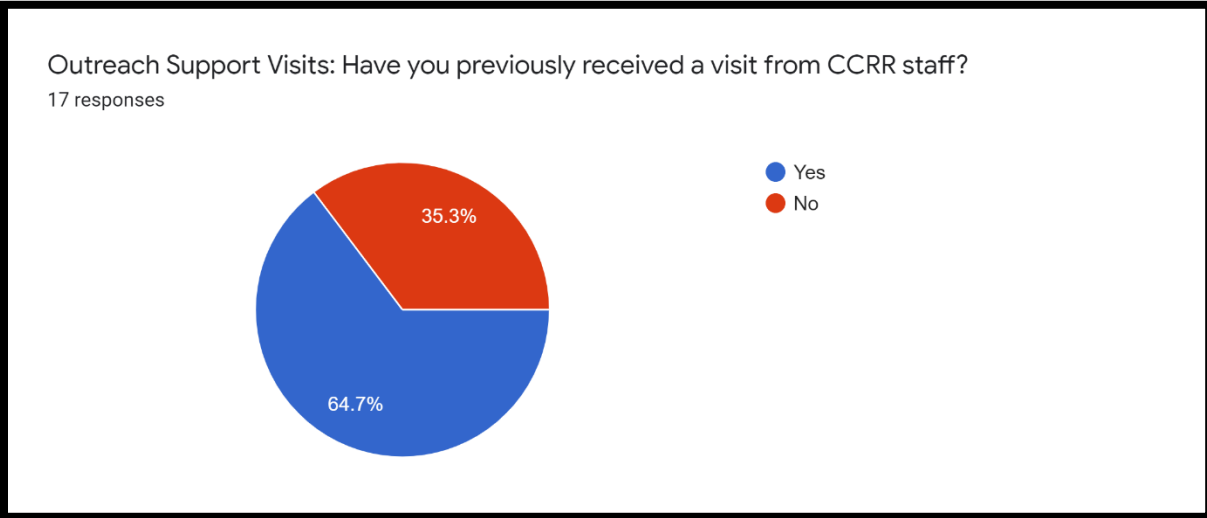


Outreach Support Visits: What was your overall satisfaction with your visit?

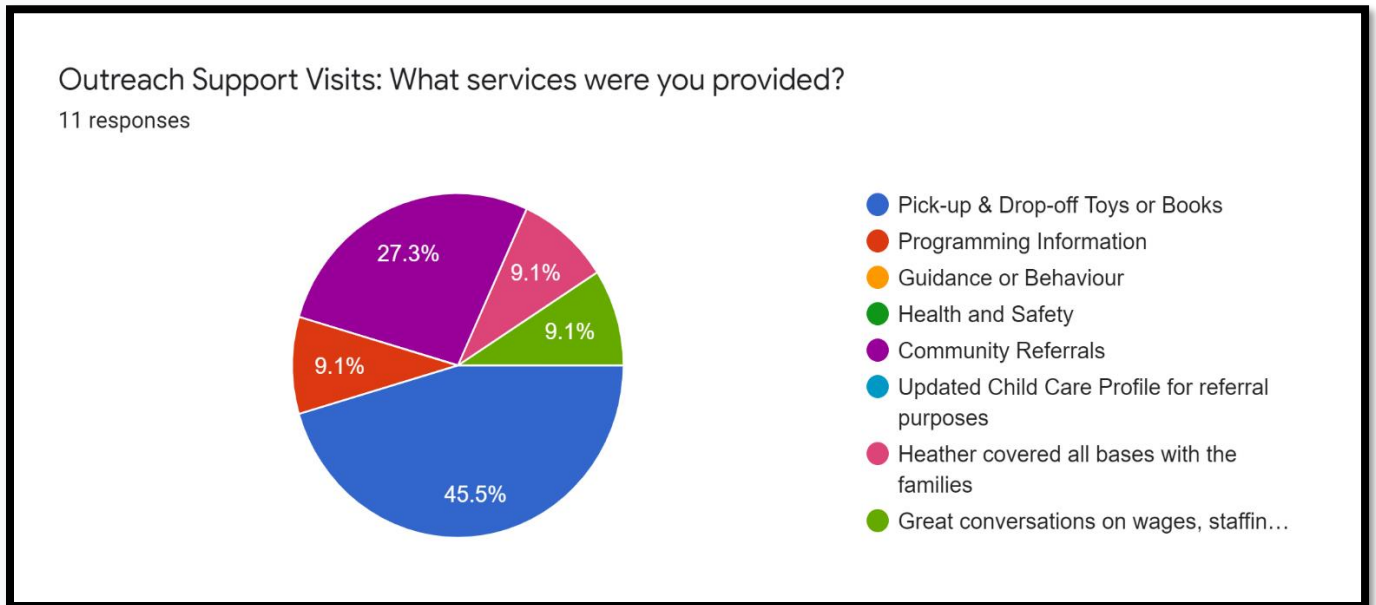
