# EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATOR – INFANT TODDLER

Kootenay Kids Society is seeking a qualified candidate for the permanent position of Infant Toddler Early Childhood Educator at the Early Care and Learning Centre.

Under the direction of the childcare centre program director, the infant toddler educator will be responsible for all aspects of planning, implementing, and documenting a comprehensive, age-appropriate, and play-based program for children in their care. You will use a family-centred approach with reflective practice as a basis for communication with other staff and families.

- Registered Early Childhood Education certificate and Registered Infant Toddler post-basic certificate in BC
- One-year experience in a childcare centre or equivalent environment
- Current recognized First Aid Certificate

- Provide mentorship and guidance to Early Childhood Educator Assistants and practicum students as required
