Kootenay Kids Society (KKS) is seeking a qualified candidate to fill the regular part-time position of Physiotherapist.

The Physiotherapist provides rehabilitation services for children aged 0 - 6 years with functional impairments. Working independently as well as collaboratively within a team, the Physical Therapist applies techniques and strategies, and directs activities related to Physiotherapy therapy to assess children's current condition and to select and prepare specific home-based or childcare setting treatment programs.

Services are child focused and are provided in the setting that best meets the child's needs whether at home, in school, on the playground or in the clinic. The Physiotherapist provides direction and support for the child, parents, teachers, and other caregivers.
